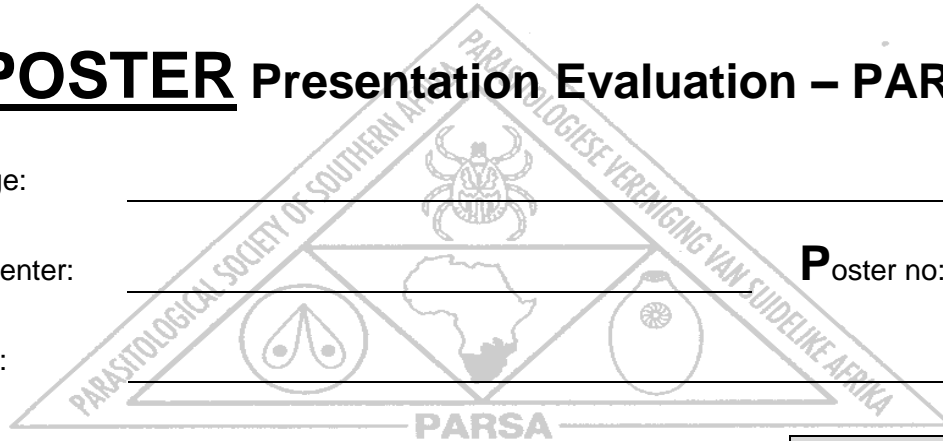

3.	Results & Discussion : <u>clearly</u> and <u>concisely</u> presented; important patterns or trends emphasized; clear insight and interpretation of results; contribution of results in context of previous studies clearly & concisely described; relevance or application of findings Comments:	15	
4.	Conclusion : clear; concise summation of important points Comments:	5	
6.	Visual Aids : <u>Integrated</u> into presentation; well-designed; attractive; appropriate font (easily read & sufficiently large); figures and tables with <u>appropriate amounts</u> of information; Photomicrographs <u>labeled</u> with <u>legends</u> ; <u>References</u> correctly given; Easy on the eye flow of information (eg. Use of bullets) Poster must be <u>self-explanatory</u> ; able to present itself clearly Comments:	15

Manner of presentation : good eye contact with audience, good volume & varying tone of voice; appropriate rate of presentation; avoid use of distracting 'fillers' (e.g., 'um', 'uh', & 'you know) or irritating mannerisms; enthusiastic presentation; effective use of reference to poster while still make eye contact with audience Duration : 3 mins.
